

RULES OF PLAY

Golf Canada rules will govern all play except where modified by local rules. When submitting scores for an official handicap on combined tees, submit as if playing from the more difficult tees.

LOCAL RULES

RULE 24-2 (FREE DROP) - All sprinkler heads, bridges, & artificially (gravel, sand, or asphalt) surfaced roads are considered immovable obstructions. All paths without artificial surfacing are not immovable obstructions. Bridges are considered immovable obstructions and provide no line-of-sight relief.


OUT OF BOUNDS - Defined by white stakes, holes: 6, 8 (road), 9, 14 & 18. If a ball is lost or out of bounds, a golfer may drop their ball in the vicinity of the lost/out of bounds ball, under a two-stroke penalty. **This rule is exempt in Championship play and for course records**

POWER LINES - A ball hitting a power line shall be replayed without penalty.

FLOWER BEDS - All flower beds and marked trees within course boundaries are free drop areas.

EVERY PLAYER

Shall have a set of golf clubs.
