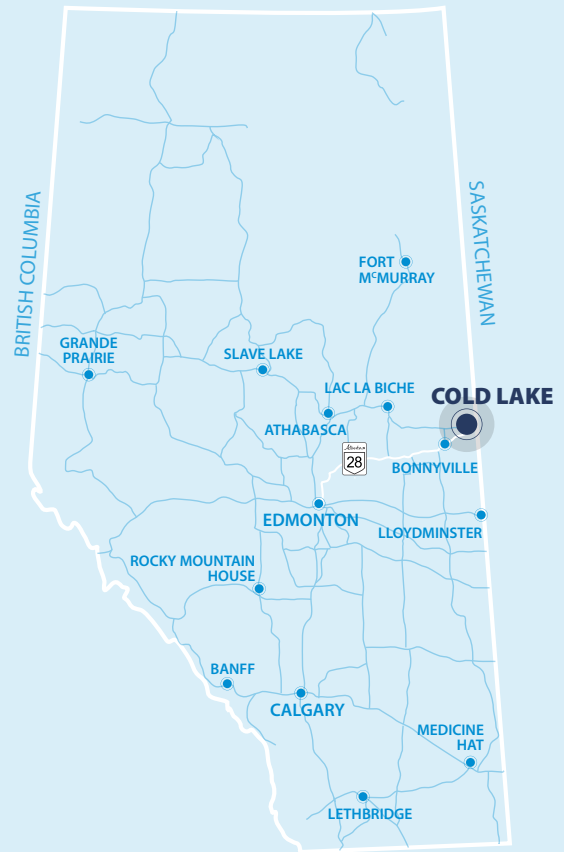

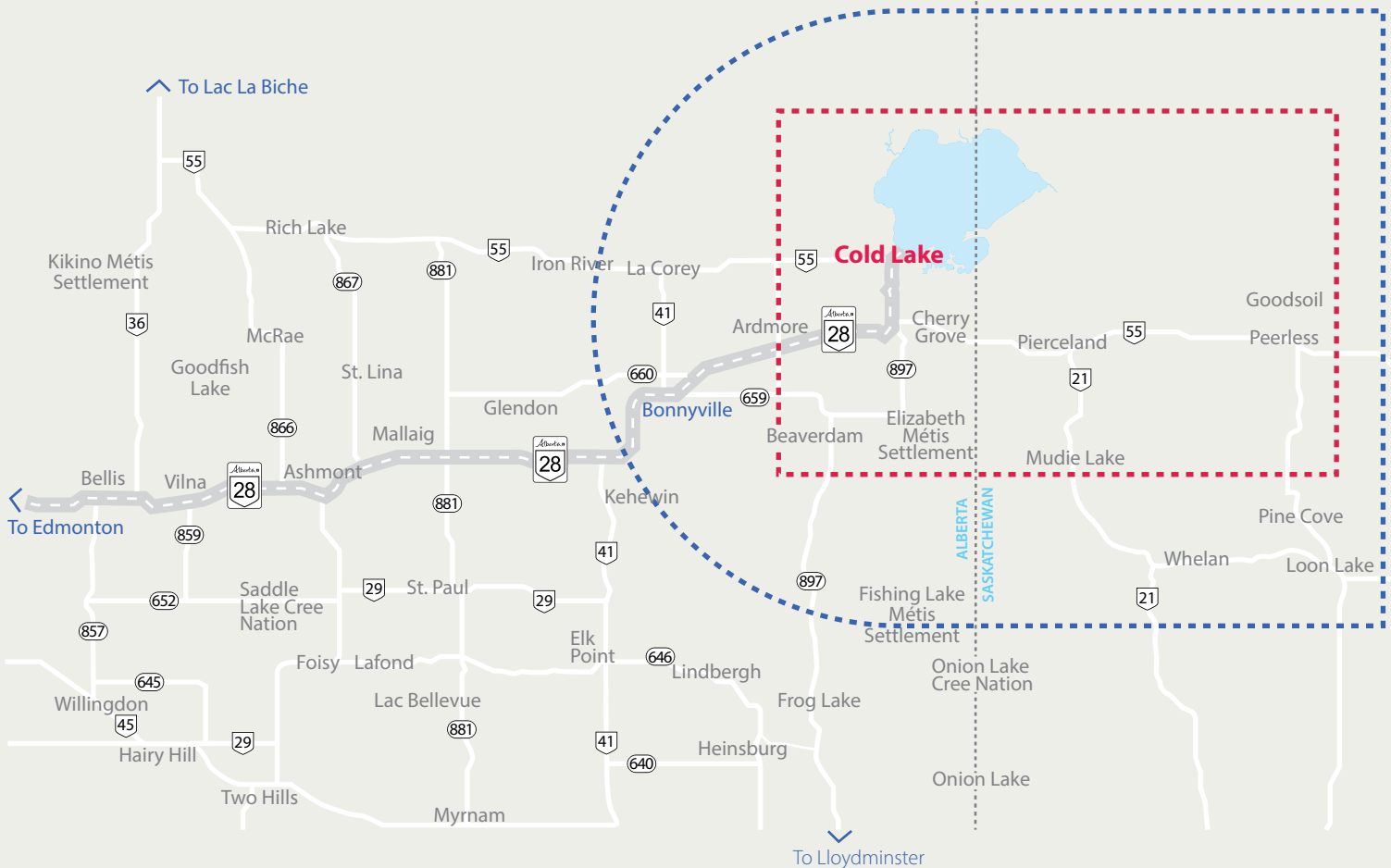

COLD LAKE



For over seven decades, Cold Lake has been the proud home of 4 Wing, the busiest fighter base in Canada.

4 Wing Cold Lake is the home of the fighter pilot. It hosts Canada's world-class tactical fighter force training and deploys and supports fighter aircraft at a moment's notice to fulfill the domestic and international roles of Canada's Air Force.

LOCATION

Located just west of Cold Lake's downtown core, Veterans Drive leads straight to 4 Wing's main gate. The back gate can be accessed via Highway 897, south of Highway 55.

VIEWING AREA

Watch aircraft during taxi and take-off from the viewing area on Kingsway Road. Just look for a gravel parking lot with bleacher seating and picnic tables. There is no set schedule for viewing.

4 WING GATEWAY PARK

Don't miss the amazing static display of historical and current aircraft at 4 Wing Gateway Park on Kingsway.

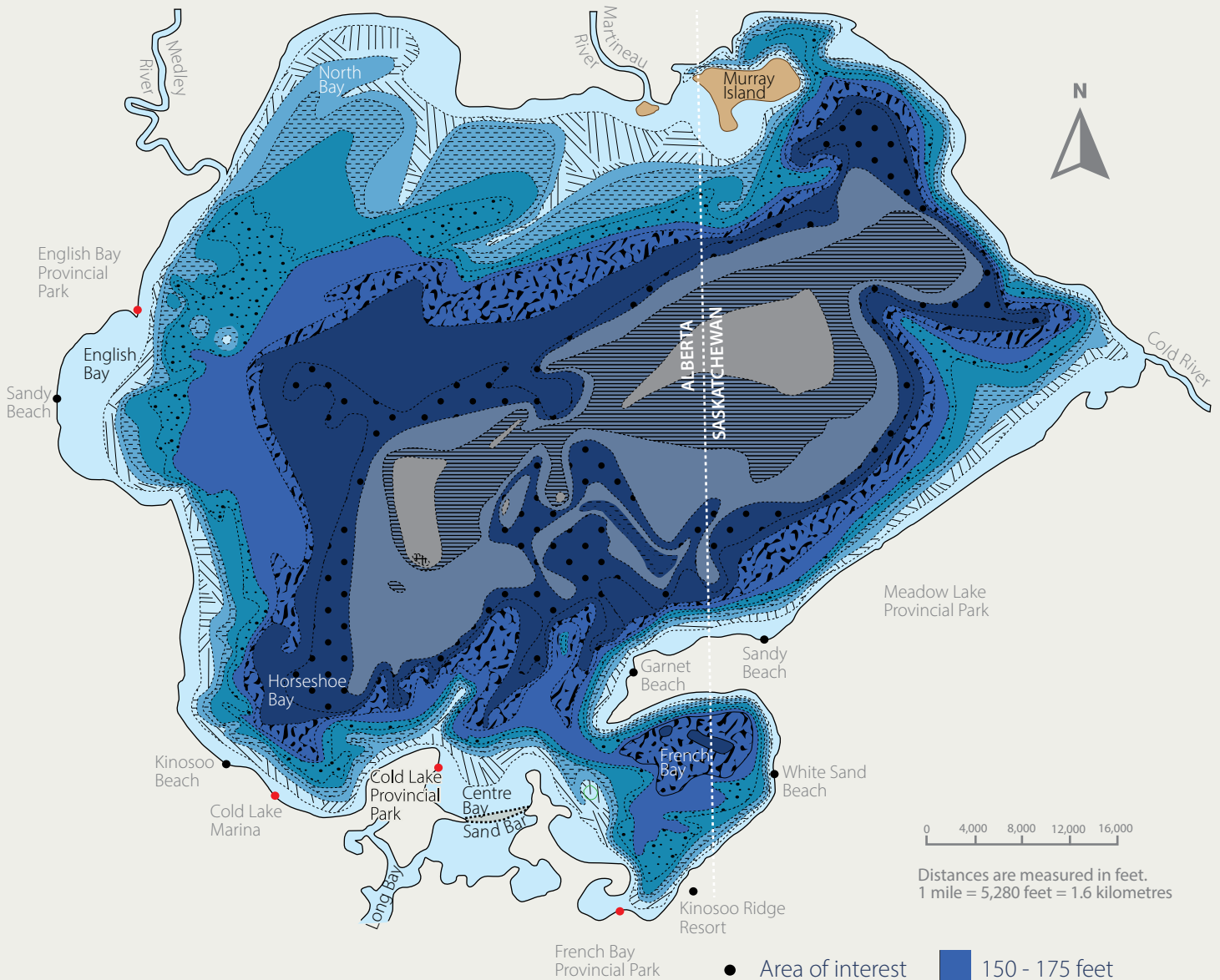
COLD LAKE

ALBERTA

Cold Lake is home to a variety of fish species, including lake trout, northern pike, walleye, yellow perch, burbot and whitefish. These game fish are sustained through a healthy population of baitfish that include cisco, white sucker, and longnose sucker.

FISHING

The lake can cater to any angler's skill level or any tactic that an angler might want to employ. Ice fishing, trolling from a boat, jigging, or fly fishing all prove effective in targeting one or more of the species.

FISHING LICENCES AND REGULATIONS

With Cold Lake lying partially in Alberta and partially in Saskatchewan, both Saskatchewan and Alberta fishing licences are valid across the entire water body. Regulations are subject to change. Anglers should verify the size and bag limits for each species in either the [Alberta](#) or [Saskatchewan](#) regulations.

MARINA

The Cold Lake Marina and boat launch is the gateway to what many call the “best lake in Alberta.”

Whether you’re heading out for a day of sailing, catching lake trout, or simply taking a stroll along the breakwater with an ice cream cone, the marina is where fun on the lake begins. Stop by during the Christmas season to see the breakwater decorated with festive holiday lights.

FUN FOR ALL AGES

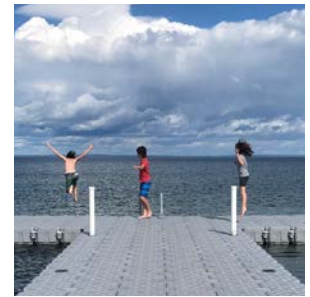

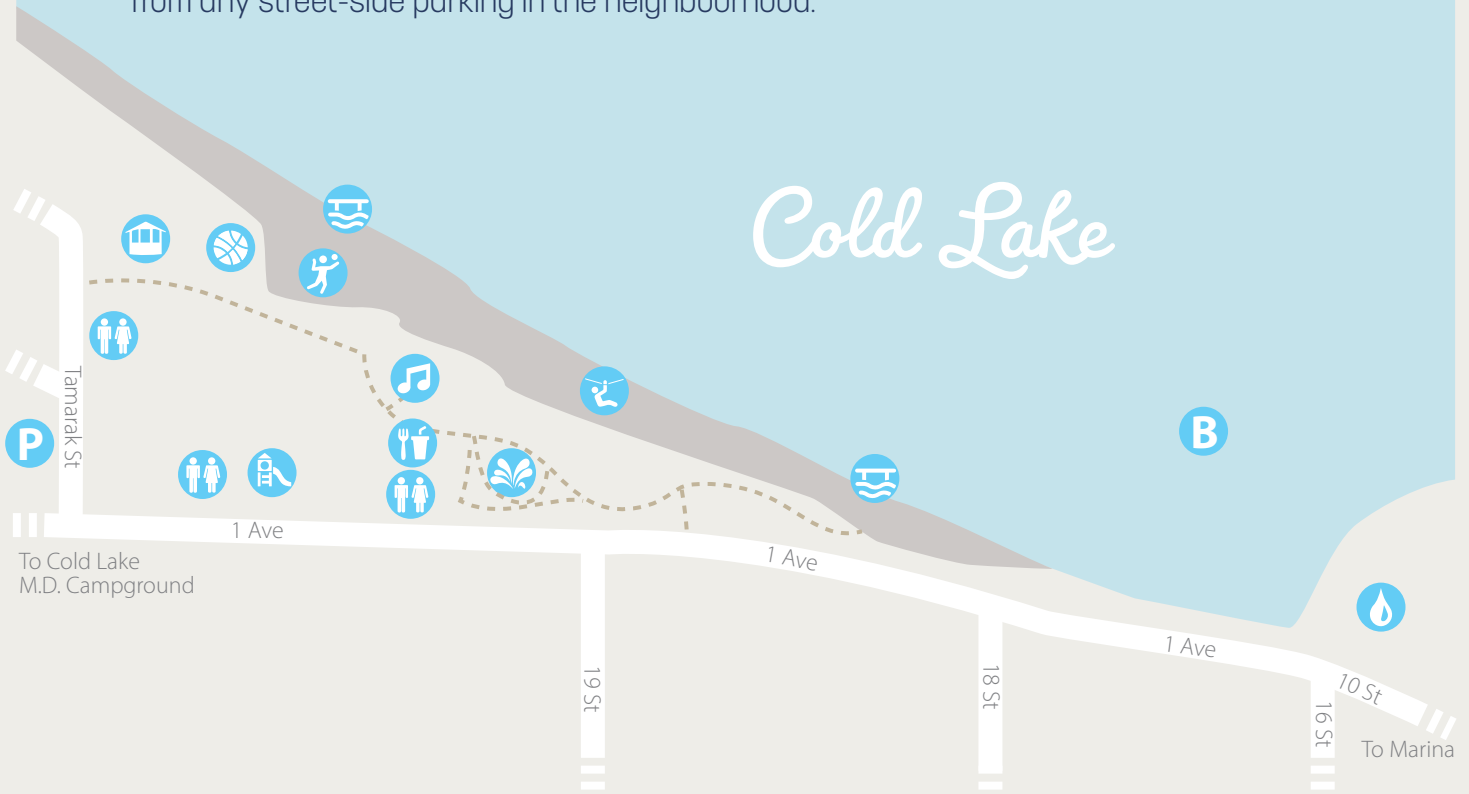


KINOSOO

REGIONAL AIRPORT

Located within the CFB Cold Lake military airspace, the Cold Lake Regional Airport (TCID: CEN5) is an uncontrolled aerodrome operated by the City of Cold Lake.

Home to a variety of fixed-wing aircraft, the Cold Lake Regional Airport is an unmanned runway used by many local and visiting pilots to the area.

The Cold Lake Regional Airport (CEN5) occupies a land area of approximately 99.5 hectares. While the airport was initially developed by the Province of Alberta in 1979, it was transferred to the City of Cold Lake in 1997. Since that time, the City has acted as the airport's owner and operator.

LOCATION

The airport is 4 km west of the City of Cold Lake and 7 km north of CFB 4 Wing Cold Lake, at 63407 Range Road 425, M.D. of Bonnyville.

RUNWAY

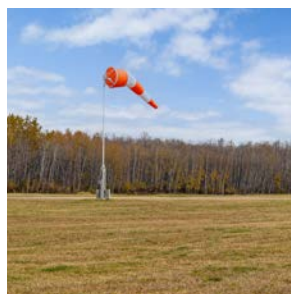
The asphalt runway is designated 08-26 and is 914.4 m (3,000 ft) in length and 22.86 m (75 ft) wide. A public apron measuring 45.7 m (150 ft) by 76.2 m (250 ft) is located to the south of runway threshold 08 and is connected to the runway via paved taxiway "A".

AIRFIELD LIGHTING

Controlled by ARCAL Type K (aircraft radio control of aerodrome lighting).

The Cold Lake Regional Airport is self-register and self-serve, meaning pilots and aircraft users have access to the fuel pumps whenever required. Assistance and leasing is available through Public Works during regular business hours.

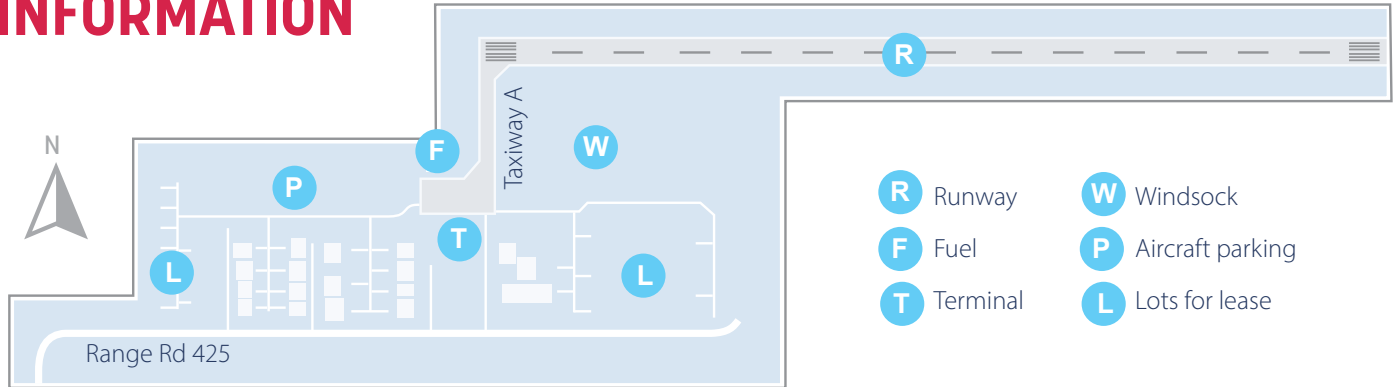

The Cold Lake Regional Airport features Global Positioning System (GPS) and Wide Area Augmentation System (WAAS) approaches. This state-of-the-art satellite navigation has increased the level of safety for both aircraft operators and carriers.

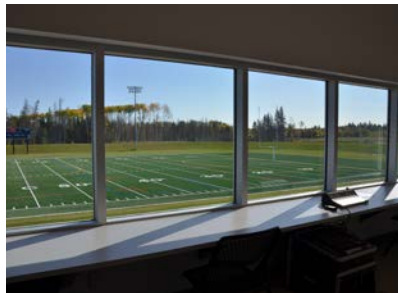

TRAILS

Cold Lake's Millennium Trail is an 11 – kilometre paved trail running from one end of the City to the other. Cleared year-round, the trail offers an excellent way to get some exercise and enjoy the great outdoors.



Whether you are getting from Point A to Point B, or whether the journey itself is the destination, the region's trails have something for all types of users.

There is an abundance of formal and informal trails throughout the region for a variety of uses: From walking and cycling to snow shoeing, cross-country skiing, and riding ATVs and snowmobiles.

IRON HORSE TRAIL

Built on a former railway easement, the Iron Horse Trail is the longest continuous recreational trail in Alberta. Take a step back in time and see historic train stations that are still standing. This trail is ready to be enjoyed any season of the year, and by a variety of travel methods. The trail is open to quads, mountain bikes, horses, horse-drawn wagons, snowmobiles, cross-country skis and hikers.

MILLENNIUM TRAIL

The 11 – kilometre Millennium Trail is commonly used by runners, cyclists, dog-walkers and for community walks. The trail connects with Heritage Trail in Cold Lake North, running alongside the lakeshore between the Cold Lake Marina and Kinosoo Beach – a great place to start out on your own urban adventure. Apart from mobility devices, users with motorized transportation are asked to ride beside the paved trail.
